Rebuilding the Chihuahua Mission: Both Spiritually and Naturally

uring a recent crisp, winter week, three Brothers from the Mexico Field Committee traveled to the Chihuahua Mission of The Church of Jesus Christ located in Cuauhtémoc, Chihuahua, Mexico to visit the Saints there and to assess the physical condition of the church building. As somewhat expected, what they discovered is encouraging with regards to the things of the

Spirit but not so encouraging with regards to the physical needs of the mission.

After many years of inconsistent spiritual leadership in Chihuahua, because of the difficult living conditions where the Church is located, some members have either left the Church or strayed. However, some very faithful members remained strong and continued in their desire to serve the Lord in this part of the vineyard. These members attended week after week to pray and sing songs, even with no Minister present.

Because of this and the need for consistent spiritual leadership in Chihuahua, Evangelist Hector Gastelum, President of the Church in Mexico, relocated his family from the warm, relatively comfortable state of Sinaloa. Mexico to Cuauhtémoc, Chihuahua where the weather is harsh, the living conditions are humble, and jobs are scarce, making it difficult to earn suitable wages. Although this relocation has been a sacrifice for them, Brother Hector and his entire family are committed to rebuilding this mission, both spiritually and naturally, with the support of the Lord. As a result of their commitment, over the last six months there are already six new members in the mission. The core group is small (approximately 15 members), but they are upholding the Church and results are beginning to be realized.

On the first day of the trip the group gathered during an afternoon meeting to discuss the necessity of the Chihuahua Mission's being successful. The Brothers encouraged the nearly 30 people gathered to keep strong in the Gospel and to begin inviting friends and relatives now that there is leadership within the mission. Again, the group confirmed they are committed to the Gospel and want to see the Church continue to grow so that many in the region will have the opportunity to come to Jesus Christ for salvation.

The Saints and friends met at a Sister's home on a Saturday afternoon for a blessed teaching, singing, and testimony service. That evening they all traveled to another Sister's home located on a ranch one hour from the mission. Again, the focus of the time

together was on singing songs of praise and sharing experiences of how God is calling many to the Gospel. They also expressed their happiness that God sent a Minister to continue the work in Chihuahua.

The subject of the Sunday preaching service was "Follow Me" from Matthew Chapter 4. II Nephi Chapter 31 was also referenced and the theme expanded to "Building The Church upon the Rock of Christ".

The Spirit of God was present in every meeting. The Lord led the group in all things and it was evident He will provide a means and a way if we have faith.

The field committee members examined the Church building during the trip and it was discovered the structure is not in good condition. Specifically, the roof leaks and water often floods the building causing damage to Church property and materials. Chihuahua is located at an elevation where it snows during the winter months and the roof is not strong enough to support this weight. Because the building is constructed of adobe brick, like many structures in Cuauhtémoc, the walls are cracking and are not strong enough to support a suitable roof to keep out the elements. The building's foundation is also cracked and there are numerous areas where water pools on the floor after a heavy rain.

These conditions are obviously not acceptable as a place for the Saints to serve the Lord. The Mexico Field Committee is determined to correct the situation as quickly as possible, but this will take many resources. After much consideration and investigation, the committee has determined the cost of repairs to the building will far exceed the cost

to purchase a new lot for a new building. Therefore, the committee believes the best possible solution is to relocate the mission to an area of new growth, closer to main roads and closer to where most of the members live.

With Brother Hector's presence and dedication to serving the mission in Chihuahua, and with the Lord's support, the Mexico Field Committee believes the congregation will continue to grow and flourish. We thank God for His goodness as the Church in Chihuahua is rebuilt both naturally and spiritually; and we look forward to witnessing much success throughout all of Mexico as the focus on spreading the Gospel continues.
